Our six-week program blends the following: Theater Education, Technology, Acting, Singing, Dance/Choreography, and Self-esteem building exercises and experiences, concluding with the presentation of a

FULL-SCALE, FAMILY-ORIENTED MUSICAL THEATRE PRODUCTION!

If you are registering more than one child- you must complete a separate registration packet for each child.

- Enrollment in *Remind* will be, if not required, HIGHLY SUGGESTED. **see note below.

Student Pre-Requisites:

- Students must be between ages 8-18 on or before June 20, 2023. (2023 high school graduates are included in this guideline!)
- The program this year will be limited to only **75 participants** (Enrollment is limited, and we honor requests for registration on a first-come, first-served basis)
- If enrollment is full before your registration materials and payment are received, your money will be refunded. (Expenses and budgeting are based on the number of students enrolled in the program, and therefore we cannot offer refunds for any reason other than reaching our enrollment capacity.)
- We do not allow students to be on the tech crew. We have Tech Classes ONLY!

Student Dress Code and Device Policy:

- For the safety of all students and staff, it is imperative that students follow our dress code guidelines. Please take notice of what your child is wearing before dropping him or her off at the Palace!
- All students (and staff) are required to wear shoes that enclose the entire foot; In other words, no sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or clogs. Tennis shoes and socks are preferred when not in costume. Only walking shorts and long pants such as leggings, athletic or sweatpants are allowed; NO short shorts. They leave more space for injury.
 - Skirts are allowable with shorts worn underneath.
 - NO JEANS-- it inhibits movement and dance! Appropriate undergarments and long or short sleeve shirts must be worn at all times; NO cap sleeves, halters, spaghetti straps, or crop tops/exposed midriffs due to dancing, stretching and bending. We don't want students to become embarrassed or worried about personal hygiene concerns. **NO HOODIES OR SWEATERS ARE ALLOWED TO BE WORN**

DURING CLASS! This is for the wellbeing of the student, as they could become overheated during classes.

They must be left in their seat.

• The use of cell phones, iPads, tablets or devices of any sort **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** during our day. They will be submitted to us at the start of the day and returned upon dismissal. In the event of an emergency, or an important message that must be delivered to your child, please contact our Producer, Laura Coteff at (440)654-6050, or the Lorain Palace Theatre at (440)245-2323. Please advise to your child that this is our standing policy and there are NO EXCEPTIONS! We want the kids to interact with each other and get to know each other, build friendships and have engaged communication without the distraction of devices. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter!

TUITION:

- Starting April 2nd, 2023, tuition is \$375 per student and <u>must be paid in full by June 20</u>, <u>2023</u>. Otherwise, your student cannot participate NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Accepted forms of payment include CASH (IN PERSON ONLY), CHECK OR MONEY ORDER, AND CREDIT CARD. (Credit card form listed below)
- Tuition includes a digital copy of the show, T-shirt, Professional Headshot, weekly prizes, and Cast Party! Not to mention the six weeks of memories your child will walk away with and the opportunity to say, "I performed at the Palace on Broadway!"
