Registration Requirements:

All Registration Forms & Payment Must Be Submitted Before June 30th, 2026 To Ensure Place In Program

- 2x3 head shot picture of Student
- Fully Filled Out Registration Packet
- Tuition Payment
- If you are registering more than one child- you must complete separate registration packets per child.

Student Pre-Requisites:

- Students must be ages 8-16 on or before June 30th, 2026
- The program this year will be limited to only 40 participants
(As enrollment is limited, spots are reserved on a first come, first serve basis with completed packet and payment)

Tuition:

- Starting May 1st, 2026 tuition is \$450 per student and must be paid in full by, June 30th, 2026 otherwise your student cannot participate – NO EXCEPTIONS!

Lorain Palace Theatre Behavior Contract

Expectations:

1. Camp is about fun, exploration, and growth. Respect for all in this process is the basic expectation.
2. Students will always treat everyone with respect and show respect for others' personal belongings, privacy, and feelings.
3. Students will remain with their teachers, follow directions, and abide by theatre rules.
4. Students will not be involved with smoking, vaping, alcohol use, illegal drugs, weapons, vandalism, theft, or any other illegal behavior.
5. Students will use appropriate language; profanity will not be tolerated.
6. All costumes and character accessories/ makeup provided by staff are to be taken care of as directed (i.e. hang them up, keep pieces together, etc.) Some characters require an actor/ actress to alter their appearance to fit the role (i.e. wigs and special effects makeup), students should accept these additional requirements without complaint.
7. Come to class each day with everything needed (i.e. a script, worksheets, sheet music, pencils and highlighters, a good lunch and plenty of water).
8. Phones will only be in students' possessions during lunchtime. If a special need arises to use a phone, ask a staff member.
9. No gum is permitted to be chewed during camp as it interferes with singing and is a safety hazard.

Unacceptable Behaviors:

The Lorain Palace Theatre has a NO TOLERANCE POLICY for violence, aggression, and threatening language. Under the circumstances below, campers will be removed from camp immediately, with the potential for this removal to be extended to camp in future years or indefinitely.

1. Discrimination of another camper/staff member, or anyone, based on race, sexual orientation, religion, age, national origin, or handicap
2. Physical fighting or violence toward another camper or staff member
3. Use or possession of illegal substances or materials intended for the use of illegal substances (drugs, vapes, alcohol, tobacco, etc.)
4. Verbal misconduct toward another child or staff member
5. Possession of weapons of any kind
6. The use of obscene, profane, or vulgar language
7. Any action that puts the safety of themselves, fellow students, or staff at risk
8. Secretly recording or photographing any individual at camp
9. Bullying behavior intended to intimidate, humiliate, demean, harass, or embarrass students or staff
10. Inappropriate physical contact with other campers and staff

Failure to follow these expectations will result in an unsafe or unenjoyable atmosphere for you and others in the camp. Should that happen, the following consequences may occur: Consequences Depending on the severity of the situation or if the behavior persists, one or more of the following consequences will be taken.

1. Staff will discuss behavior with the student.
2. Staff will discuss the behavior with the parent/guardian.
3. The child will be sent home immediately for the day.
4. In extreme cases child will be sent home and not allowed to return to camp.
5. NOTE: There are no refunds when a child's behavior requires they be sent home or removed from the program.

I acknowledge that the regular class day ends at 2:30 PM with standard pick up period from 2:30 PM to 2:45 PM.

I acknowledge that I am responsible for providing enough non-perishable food for my child to have a complete lunch and a bottle of water. I also acknowledge that Lorain Palace Theatre staff cannot provide any food or drink to children, nor provide any refrigeration of children's lunches.

On behalf of my child and for myself, I knowingly assume all risks arising from participation in activities related to camp programming. I certify that I have legal authority to sign this release/waiver of liability, and sign it without duress or coercion.

The Lorain Palace Theatre will occasionally use photos/videos in our publicity material, including, but not limited to, social media, our website, bulletin boards, brochures, etc. I authorize the release of my child's photograph/image as "publicity/performance records".
